

## SIXTH FORM DRESS REGULATIONS

### SMART DAYS

Mondays and Fridays are Smart Days.

The first day back after any holiday, no matter how short, is a Smart Day.

Formal occasions such as visits, away matches, church services, house/school photos, guiding visitors, etc. require smart dress.

<b>Overview</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <b>Boys and Girls</b> are to wear business style suits. The tailored suit must be comprised of a jacket and trousers/skirt of matching colour and material.</li> <li>■ Casual shoes or trainers are not to be worn on Smart Days.</li> <li>■ No facial piercings.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Ties are to be worn and top buttons are to be done up.</li> <li>■ To be clean shaven.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Skirts are to be just above the knee or longer.</li> <li>■ Trouser Suits are acceptable.</li> <li>■ No stiletto heels or 'UGG' style boots.</li> </ul>

### CASUAL DAYS

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday are Casual Days.

<b>Overview</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ All clothes must be clean and in good condition.</li> <li>■ You must always be dressed for a day of work. Flip flops, shorts and pyjama bottoms are not acceptable.</li> <li>■ Logos must be discreet and inoffensive.</li> <li>■ Conventional jewellery, including earrings, is permitted, but any other facial jewellery and tongue piercings are not.</li> <li>■ Hair should always be clean and tidy.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ To be clean shaven.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Skirts must not be too short and necklines must not be too low.</li> <li>■ Bare midriffs and bra straps must not be seen. Off-the-shoulder tops, narrow strapped tops and narrow strapped dresses are not acceptable.</li> </ul>
