

HOUSE RULES FOR BOARDING STUDENTS THAT USE A CAR

Students Bringing a Car into School

1. Any student who brings a car into school should use house parking and hand their car key in to the duty member of staff on arrival.
2. Generally, cars should not be used during the week by boarding students; however they may be used mid-week for approved trips with prior parental and head of boarding house permission (e.g. for university visits)

Taking Passengers in Student Cars

1. Any student travelling in another student's car for the first time will need permission from their parent to travel with that student driving. Parents may give permission for all future trips with the same student driving if it is an ongoing arrangement.
2. Parents of students with cars may give instruction or permission for their child:
 - a. Never to drive other students as passengers in their car
 - b. To be allowed to drive specific named students as passengers
 - c. To drive any Cranbrook school student as a passenger after first obtaining parental permission for each trip
 - d. To drive any Cranbrook school student at any time
 - e. The above information should be given to the students head of boarding house directly.
