Webster Boys is comprised of students who live closest to the school and is one of the largest day Houses.

We work closely with Webster Girls – no surprise, for the same families are often represented in both Houses. We seek to promote a model in which the boys feel ownership in the House in its academic, social and sporting activities, supported by highly experienced and supportive staff through pastoral and academic guidance. Our House objective is to develop a community that combines personal aspirations with the consideration of others.

Webster House assemblies are overseen by the Head of House but involve students and tutors alike, allowing the opportunity for all to share their views and ideas. Although the House Captain and his Deputy meet fortnightly with Mr Maimi, The House Council draws from others and meets termly, helping to make strategic decisions, while the various House Captains assist in the day to day running of the House. This sense of commitment and student led involvement is evident whether it be leading up to a house social activity or during inter-House events at which we often excel.

There is a varied programme of events and activities during the year: in the autumn term we hold a welcome BBQ and inter year group football tournament. This is followed by a quiz and bake off, contesting the girls half of Webster House. Our Christmas party involves formal dress and a dinner, also with the girls. During the spring, demand is such that we hold both a junior and senior meal off site at a suitable restaurant. Food does seem to be a common theme though, as each tutor group holds an informal tutorial in the George Hotel over a cooked breakfast. Inter house events are hotly contested. All Webster Boys are involved in the inter-House Singing Competition (aka the 'House Shout'), while Rugby, Cross Country, Hockey, Football, Swimming and Athletics also see Webster boys turning out in their vibrant green and yellow house colours.
