School uniform is available for purchase from Phillips Mens Shop in Cranbrook. The shop is located in the High Street. Uniform is also available for purchase online. However, we do suggest that if you are purchasing uniform for the first time that you visit the shop in person so that your child may be fitted specifically for various items.

Overview

All Students in Years 9 – 11 are to wear school uniform throughout the school day (PE and games excepted). Certain activities may require practical clothes. These may only be worn for the activity itself, not at other times. Permission is needed and should not be assumed.

Summer uniform may be worn during the summer term after the May Bank holiday. This uniform is the school polo shirt and, optionally, the maroon sweater. Pupils can choose to wear full uniform and many do in cold weather.

Boys in Years 9 – 11

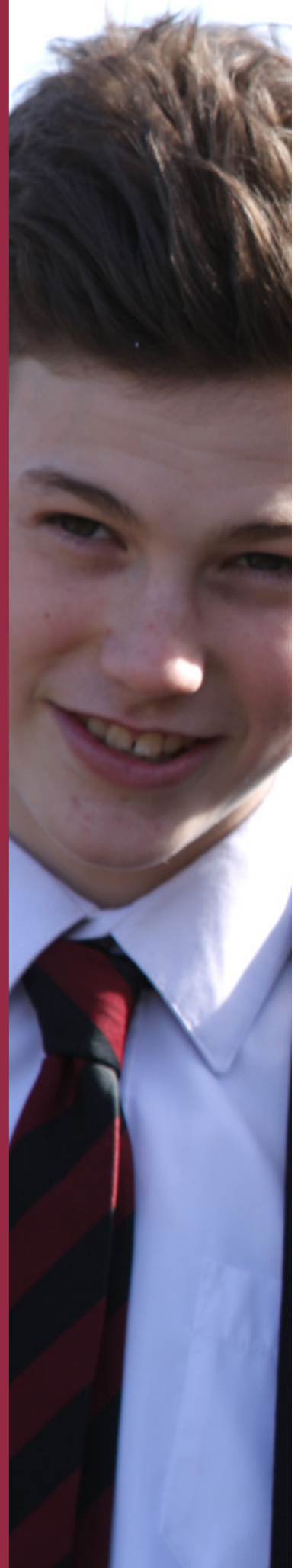
- No jewellery is allowed, except a watch.

Girls in Years 9 – 11

- The jewellery allowed is a watch, one stud earring per ear and a slim chain
- Headbands may be worn but must not be adorned with flowers or any other decoration
- Discreet make-up may be worn
- No coloured nail varnish is allowed.

Marking Uniform and PE Kit

Name tags must be sewn on the inside of all clothing items, and all sports equipment must be clearly marked.

Important information about white blouses:
