School Lodge



This is a truly unique boarding house as all Year 9 male boarders move straight into School Lodge. They live here for one year before being allocated to their senior Houses, where they will spend their remaining years until they leave school. This is a very traditional and increasingly rare setting, and is one of the biggest selling points of the School for the boys. Not only is School Lodge the only youngest House, but it also epitomises both the family feel and brotherhood that Cranbrook School is so proud of.









School Lodge is a warm, homely place which encourages our youngest boarders to try new things. The kitchen is purpose built for them to cook up snacks between meal times and get together as a group after school to unwind. There are lots of social spaces for the boys to get together and chat—the biggest being the lounge which can hold all the boys at once.

Brand new to School Lodge this year is the reading room. This was previously the matron's room and has been renovated to provide a quiet additional space to the House.

The room has no TV but has plenty of board games and books to encourage the boys to sit, chill and chat—there is even a 'no phones' policy for this room!

The rooms vary in size from the House's three two-bed rooms to its largest 10-bed dorm on the top floor. Each year, the popularity of these dorms changes; sometimes the two-bed rooms are seen as a luxury, but most of the time the largest dorm is the most popular as it becomes the hub of social activity.
