- **Tanzania Expedition 2020:** We are pleased to announce that Trueadventure are organising a second major expedition for Cranbrook School following the very successful trip to Nepal last year. This will be to Tanzania in July 2020. The expedition will involve adventurous projects including trekking and a safari, and it will also include community work in various remote villages in collaboration with the FUM charity that the school has enjoyed links with for many years. The expedition is again being organised and led by Trueadventure, one of the leading providers in the country.
