#### Notices:

- **Vaccinations:** Please be aware that the Kent Community Health Immunisation Team will be in school Wednesday 27th and Thursday 28th March to administer the DTP and Meningitis ACWY vaccinations to students in Year 9 who have consent. Information concerning these vaccinations was sent to parents via ParentMail on 1st March. The immunisations will take place during the school day. The list of appointment times will be posted on the front door of the medical centre next week with reminders to check it given in the daily Notices.
- **Student drop-off/collection:** Please can we remind parents/guardians who collect students at the end of the school day to use the In/Out drop-off and collection zones at the front of the school. Please do not wait there for long periods of time before or after collecting your child. In order to ease congestion along Waterloo Road, you may wish to consider dropping your child off in Cranbrook town so they can walk the final stretch to school. We would also request that parents do not block this area when collecting their children following school clubs and sports matches. If cars are lined up and waiting along the road, this causes a block in traffic and prevents the public buses from accessing the High Street, as well as causing a problem for emergency vehicles using Waterloo Road. If you are collecting a student following a club or sports fixture, you are welcome to use the Barham Drive car parks located behind and along from the Sports Hall. Thank you for your support.
- **Inspire STEM residential courses:** EDT partner universities would like to engage with Year 10 female students and offer a chance to attend a Year 11 *Inspire STEM* based residential course this summer. It is important these individuals are mature, motivated and ready to step up for the challenge ahead.
