## Two-day youth mental health first aid course - Saturdays 19th and 26th September

The course costs £75 per person for the two days, this is highly subsidised by the SWF. It will be held at Dulwich Prep School, Cranbrook. 9-5pm on 19th and 26th September and is open to anyone who comes into contact with young people aged 8 to 18 years. The course covers depression, anxiety, suicide, self-harming, eating disorders and how to look after our own mental health.
