

# School Uniform

School uniform is available for purchase from Phillips Man's Shop in Cranbrook. The shop is located in the High Street. Uniform is also available for purchase online; however, we do suggest that if you are purchasing uniform for the first time that you visit the shop in person so that your child may be fitted specifically for various items.



## **Lower School Uniform**

High standards of dress and appearance are very important. Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform in a presentable condition at all times while in school, and to and from school. The school's sanctions system will be applied for any uniform infringements.

- A small watch may be worn. If ears are pierced, one pair of small plain gold or silver ear studs may be worn. Earrings may only be worn in the ear lobe. Piercings of any other kind are not allowed and students will be required to remove these. No other jewellery, including friendship bracelets or anklets, is permitted. All piercings should be undertaken at the end of the summer term in July so that they can be removed by September.
- Hair should be a natural colour for the student, and must be neat, tidy and smart. If braids are worn, these should be natural colour. No extremes of style, including shaved or partly shaved heads are permitted. Headscarves are only permitted for religious reasons. Hair fastenings should be discrete.
- Nail varnish or false nails may not be worn. Students are expected to remove both before attending school.
- No make-up is allowed in Key Stage 3. Key Stage 4 students may wear discreet make-up only – thin mascara and light foundation, but no lipstick, eye liner or eye shadow.
- School bags should be waterproof, appropriate for school and able to be fastened to protect contents.
- All items of P.E kit must be school issue and should be clearly marked with the student's name.

If parents require advice about colour, length, style or anything else when purchasing clothing, please contact the Head of House or Deputy Head.

Please note that should any pupil feel that they wish to wear uniform that is different to that assigned to their sex, the School will be happy to consider changes that conform to the level of smartness in these dress regulations. Please contact the Deputy Head if this is the case.

### **Important information:**

#### White Blouses:

Blouses can be purchased from either Phillips Mens Shops or from other High Street stores. However, it is essential they comply with the following rules:

- Plain White, button fastening
- $\frac{3}{4}$  Length Sleeves
- Shaped to sit outside of the skirt, covering the waistband
- White or skin coloured bra only to be worn underneath

Shoes:

- Black traditional school shoes should be leather or alternative but able to be polished – not fabric.
- Plain black flat or low-heeled shoes with backs.
- Boots or canvas shoes/plimsolls are not allowed.
- Flat or low-heeled means no higher than 4cm from the top to the bottom of the heel. Platforms no higher than 1.5cm.
- No trainers allowed e.g.

Trousers for boys and girls:

Trousers can be purchased from either Philips Mans Shops or other High Street stores. They must be:

- School trousers
- Dark charcoal grey
- Ankle length
- Straight or slim leg not skinny leg
- Not leggings, jeans, jeggings or casual trousers
