I can use, recognise, notate and improvise rhythmically and confidently using a variety of more complex but appropriate rhythms, which I can also notate by ear including syncopation, cross rhythms and triplets. I can use the keywords to describe music I play and hear accurately.
5	I can follow the correct structure and can read rhythm grids and notation accurately. I can improvise an extended solo confidently. I can recognise complex semiquaver, quaver, crotchet and minim patterns and can notate these accurately when heard. I know and understand all keywords and their definitions too.
4	I can recognise simple quavers, crotchets and minims and can notate these accurately. I can improvise a rhythm pattern in time and can improvise a short solo, if required. I understand how simple structures work in music. I know and understand most of the keywords and some definitions. I know all of the note names, symbols, lengths and rests.
3	I can improvise or play a rhythm in time with other members of my group and can keep my rhythm going in performance work. I can recognise simple crotchet, minims and quaver patterns and can notate these when I hear them. I can join in with my group and understand the different sections. I know most keywords and definitions.
2	I can improvise or play a regular rhythm in time with other members of my group. I can recognise simple crotchet, minim and quaver patterns and can use these in my composition work. I know what most of the keywords are and some definitions.
1	I can maintain and play a repeated steady rhythm on a percussion instrument. I can recognise simple crotchet and minim patterns and can notate these when heard. I know what most of the keywords are. I can use basic notation to compose successfully.
