Uniform is also available for purchase online; however, we do suggest that if you are purchasing uniform for the first time that you visit the shop in person so that your child may be fitted specifically for various items.

Lower School Uniform

High standards of dress and appearance are very important. Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform in a presentable condition at all times while in school, and to and from school. The school's sanctions system will be applied for any uniform infringements.

This list was reviewed, following consultation, in December 2022 to reflect new legislation around school uniform affordability. A number of items which previously had to be purchased through our school uniform suppliers can now be purchased at any retailer and a number of items which were previously optional have been taken off the list. A number of items have been changed to a less expensive alternative. If you wish to discuss any aspect of school uniform, please contact the school office.

All students joining the school from September 2023 should wear this new school uniform. Current students may wear the new school uniform should they wish. The legacy uniform will be permitted until 2027.

- A small watch may be worn. If ears are pierced, one pair of small plain gold or silver ear studs may be
 worn. Earrings may only be worn in the ear lobe. Piercings of any other kind are not allowed and
 students will be required to remove these. No other jewellery, including friendship bracelets or anklets, is
 permitted. All piercings should be undertaken at the end of the summer term in July so that they can be
 removed by September.
- Hair should be a natural colour for the student, and must be neat, tidy and smart. If braids are worn, these should be natural colour. No extremes of style, including shaved or partly shaved heads are permitted. Headscarves are only permitted for religious reasons. Hair fastenings should be discreet.
- Nail varnish or false nails may not be worn. Students are expected to remove both before attending school.
- No make-up is allowed in Key Stage 3. Key Stage 4 students may wear discreet make-up only thin mascara and light foundation, but no lipstick, eye liner or eye shadow.
- All items of PE kit, school uniform and bags must be clearly marked with the student's name.
